

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. An exhibitor who violates any of the following rules will forfeit all privileges and premium and be subject to such penalty as the Executive Committee may direct.
2. All exhibits will be under the control and direction of the Fair Board, but the Fair will in no case be responsible for any consequential or other loss, injury or damage done to, or occasioned by, or arising from any animal or article exhibited by the exhibitor, and for its description as given in the catalogue, and shall indemnify the Fair against all legal or other proceedings in regard thereto.
3. The Fair Board will put forth every effort to protect all exhibits, and a watchman will be provided by the Fair Board where and when deemed necessary for the best interest of the exhibitors, and all exhibitors of cattle, horse, sheep, swine, poultry, and other livestock will be responsible for the care and feeding of the animals.
4. All applications for the entries must be made out on printed forms and in accordance with the instructions on the same. These forms, after being completed by the exhibitor, must be filed in the correct place by July 15th, unless otherwise specified in the premium list.
5. Exhibitor numbers must be secured upon registration at the Administration Building.
6. No persons having entered an exhibit for competition will be allowed to make a substitution of animals or otherwise change the entry after five days prior to the opening of the fair, except as noted in Rule 7. Prize ribbons and other Awards must be displayed during the exposition or any otherwise specified in the premium list.
7. Exhibits that have been erroneously entered may, at the discretion of the management, be transferred to their proper classes previous to the judging, but if such classes shall have been judged they shall not be opened.
8. Exhibit cards filled in with appropriate information must be displayed for each animal.
9. **NO GAMBLING, IMMORAL, EXHIBITIONS, INTOXICATED PERSONS, OR ANY INTOXICATING BEVERAGES OR DRUGS WILL BE ALLOWED ON THE FAIRGROUNDS.**
10. Smoking in the barns is forbidden by rules and regulations of the Crawford County Fair Association and these rules be rigidly enforced.
11. All Exhibitor Campers will pay \$60.00 fee for the week. All other Campers will pay \$110.00. **NO CAMPERS** will be admitted before 8:00 a.m. Thursday, August 20. All campers will be registered and pay \$60.00 fee upon entry to the fairgrounds. **NO** campers will be admitted after 10:00 p.m. any day All campers will be parked where designated. **SEE CAMPER RULES.**
12. The Fair Management reserves the right to amend

or add to these rules and regulations as its judgment may determine.

13. NO PARKING in Fire Lane or vehicles WILL be towed away at owner's expense.

14. The Crawford County Fair and Fair Board are not responsible for articles left. ALL ARTICLES ARE TO BE PICKED UP BETWEEN 1:00 P.M. AND 3:00 P.M. ON SUNDAY, AUGUST 30th.

15. NO ANIMALS ALLOWED ON THE GROUNDS OTHER THAN THOSE BEING EXHIBITED.
