

Witness and Jury Pay

The Treasurer's office pays jurors and witnesses for the courts. Witnesses receive \$5.00 per day plus mileage @ \$.075 per mile. All witnesses receive a paper from the District Attorney's Office indicating the number of days they served, mileage, and the total amount due them. Cash is disbursed to witnesses who present the paper in the Treasurer's office. Jurors are also paid cash and some receive a check for their services. They receive \$9.00 per day for each day they serve. Those who serve more than 3 days receive \$25.00 per day exceeding the 3 days. Jurors also receive round trip mileage computed @ \$.17 per mile. Sometimes a case is settled after business hours and jurors may not be able to come back to the courthouse for a cash payment. The courts ask these jurors to contact the Treasurer's office with their mileage. Letters for employers are issued upon request.
