- 1. Notification from Parker Lord Corporation regarding their intent to apply to PA DEP for Chapter 127 renewal permitting for their Saegertown facility. This facility manufactures several types of adhesives and coating products, including elastomer products (rubber-to-metal adhesives), industrial coatings, industrial and automotive adhesives, and laminating adhesives. These products are produced through batch reaction, blending, dispersion, and filtration operations. Activities take place in Saegertown Borough.
- 2. Notification from Pin Oak Midstream, LLC regarding their intent to apply to PA DEP for renewal of their Air Quality General Permit for a natural gas compression and/or processing facility. Activities take place in Randolph Township.
