All defendants and additional defendants shall file pretrial statements within 45 days after the certificate of readiness is filed. A pretrial conference will be scheduled generally during the first full week of the month prior to the start of the trial term.

Miscellaneous hearings and other matters will be scheduled as needed upon motion or as otherwise provided by statute or rule.

Inactive cases will be terminated on June 3, 2024 pursuant to Cra.R.C.P. 302.
