CRAWFORD COUNTY COVID-19 POSITIVES IS AT 16 County Actively Supporting Pandemic Response and Keeping Government Operating New confirmed cases in the Commonwealth see a large increase from yesterday's total

MEADVILLE, PA – While the number of confirmed COVID-19 cases in the Commonwealth increased by over 1,700 today, bringing the Statewide total to near 30,000, the number of Crawford County residents testing positive for the virus remains at 16. Crawford County Commissioners and County Department Heads/Elected Officials have been working non-stop during this pandemic with local, State and Federal agencies in an effort to keep providing essential services to County residents.

As a result of the most recent directive from Governor Wolf and the Pennsylvania Department of Health related to wearing masks, effective Sunday, April 16 at 8:00 pm, any person who is not a Crawford County employee seeking entrance to any County facility must wear a mask in order to gain admittance. This includes, but is not limited to, vendors and members of the public who choose, or are required, to visit a County facility for essential business.

If a person arrives at a County facility without wearing a mask, they may be denied access to the facility and will not be permitted inside unless they wear a mask. These measures are being implemented with care and the utmost consideration for the health and well-being of our citizens and our staff. The County Commissioners and Department Heads/Elected Officials continue to monitor the necessary CDC (www.CDC.gov) recommendations to ensure their facilities, employees and the public are safe.

Please follow the instructions of State and Federal health officials to stay calm, stay home, stay safe and wear a mask if going out.
