

Pricing Schedule for Sale of Public Information from County Databases and service pricing to support Tax Collection processes.

In their regularly scheduled meeting, the Crawford County Board of Commissioners approved the following Pricing Schedule:

Hard Copy (Paper) Lists/Labels:

Government Entities:	\$.05 per parcel up to \$40.00 per district
Non-Taxable Entities:	\$.05 per parcel up to \$40.00 per district
Private Industry:	\$.07 per parcel up to \$60.00 per district
Labels:	\$.08 per parcel up to \$35.00 per district

Data Export Services [available file formats: Microsoft Excel or ASCII CSV]

Government Entities:	\$.05 per parcel up to \$40.00 per district
Non-Taxable Entities:	\$.05 per parcel up to \$40.00 per district
Private Individual:	\$.07 per parcel up to \$60.00 per district
Private Industry:	\$.07 per parcel up to \$60.00 per district
County-wide lists:	\$ 550.00 Flat Fee for Entire County

Tax Bills/Duplicates: (services for Tax Collectors only, not subject to minimum service charge)

Tax Bills (Blanks, 2nd Notice, Copies)	\$.05 per page
Copies of Duplicates (Laser Printed, legal)	\$.05 per page
Print Room costs (when used)	Cost pass through from Print Room

The minimum charge for service is \$40.00. If your order does not add up to this minimum charge then the minimum charge will apply! In addition to the charges above, there will be assessed fees for supplies, postage and special programming as applicable.

As part of intergovernmental information requirements, the county retains the option to waive charges to government entities where necessary to promote Crawford County interests. The authority to waive charges for governmental agencies rests with the Board of Commissioners.

Crawford County grants the purchaser of data rights to use the data to meet their own internal requirements. However, purchasers have no right to redistribute the data purchased for profit.
