

NEU'S SELF-CERTIFICATION OF BUDGET AMOUNT

The American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 provides that the total amount of fiscal recovery funds allocated and distributed by states to nonentitlement units of local government (NEUs), including the sum of both the first and second tranches of funding, cannot exceed an amount equal to 75 percent of the most recent budget for the NEU as of January 27, 2020. According to the U.S. Department of the Treasury's Interim Final Rule, "the most recent budget" is the NEU's most recent annual total operating budget, including its general fund and other funds, as of January 27, 2020. In order to calculate the 75-percent cap, the Interim Final Rule allows a state to rely on a certified top-line budget total from an authorized officer of an NEU. *See* 42 U.S.C. § 803(b)(2)(C)(iii); 86 F.R. 26786, 26814, 26824 (May 17, 2021).
