OFFICIAL NOTICE OF ELECTION FOR MILITARY AND OVERSEAS VOTERS
CRAWFORD COUNTY
May 19, 2026

This is an official notice of an election to be conducted on **May 19, 2026** in Crawford County. Military and overseas electors may register to vote and request an official absentee ballot by using the Federal Postcard Application (FPCA), available at www.fvap.gov, www.votespa.com, or this website. You may apply for an absentee ballot by submitting your FPCA by fax to (814)-337-0457 or by email to jmcfarland@co.crawford.pa.us.

Military and overseas electors may request an absentee ballot from this office any time prior to a Primary or General Election by completing the Federal Post Card Application (FPCA). However, if time does not permit you to receive and return an official absentee ballot by the deadline, you are entitled to vote using the Federal Write-In Absentee Ballot (FWAB), available at www.fvap.gov and this website. Military electors may use the FCAP or FWAB to register to vote and vote simultaneously. The FWAB can be used to vote for all state, and local offices, and ballot initiatives. To vote, refer to the instructions and page 3 of the FWAB application. ***Please note that the FCAP should be completed and submitted first*** and the FWAB ONLY if time is of the essence and the ballot could not feasibly be returned by the deadline.

To vote for state and local offices and ballot initiatives, write the names of the candidates or ballot initiatives in the Addendum section of the FWAB. Under the **Office/ Ballot Initiative** heading, enter the office the candidate is running for or the title of the Ballot Initiative (referendum). Under the **Candidate Name, Party Affiliation, or Initiative Vote** heading, list the name of the candidate you wish to vote for, or if you are voting on a Referendum question write "Yes" or "No".

NOTE: The official list of candidates for nomination to public offices and election to party offices may be updated due to candidate withdrawals and litigation. This notice will be updated as the official list of candidates is being finalized.

Electing 1 male, 1 female, and 1 of either gender.

DEMOCRATIC COUNTY COMMITTEE

FOUR YEAR TERM

Electing ONE local Committeeman and ONE local Committeewoman per precinct.

REPUBLICAN COUNTY COMMITTEE

FOUR YEAR TERM

Electing not more than TWO Committee People without distinction between gender per precinct.
