
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 13

TRANSPORTING ITEMS INTO THE JUDICIAL CENTER

AND NOW, **December 4, 2020**, pursuant to this Court's Declaration of Judicial Emergency, *see* Case No. 27 WM 2020, and until further order of the Court, the following is hereby ORDERED, DIRECTED, and DECREED, effective immediately:

1. To limit the potential exposure to the COVID-19 virus of both visitors and staff of the Crawford County Judicial Center, and minimize screening time upon entrance, only such items as are reasonably necessary for the fulfillment of functions, duties, or other authorized activities therein may be carried or otherwise transported into the Judicial Center;
2. Included are pocketbooks, briefcases, packages, etc.;
3. The Sheriff and his deputies shall be arbiters of what items are "reasonably necessary"; and
4. Visitors may be permitted to bring additional, non-necessary items solely at the discretion of the Sheriff.
