

AND NOW, this 28th day of May, 2025 after argument on the Commonwealth's Motion in Limine/Notice of Intent to use Prior Bad Acts pursuant to Pa.R.E. 404(b) and on the Commonwealth's Amended Motion in Limine/Notice of Intent to use Prior Bad Acts pursuant to Pa.R.E. 404(b), it is hereby ORDERED that evidence of the alleged burglary at Lester Byler's residence and evidence of the alleged burglary at Rachel Miller's residence shall be admissible.
